In January 2010, we will begin a personal evangelism emphasis entitled "Each One, Reach One." This emphasis will continue through June of 2010 and during this time each one of us will be encouraged and challenged to focus on one person from our Impact List to lead to Christ. ## **Global Missions Offering**

Last month, we kicked off the fourth year of our Global Missions Offering (GMO)! What is the GMO? Three years ago, we combined our multiple traditional offerings with our short-term mission trip needs and created the Global Missions Offering. We also now use a portion of the GMO to support our ministry with Vedat.

Our theme for the 2009 GMO is "Who's Missing? Whose Mission?" More than 1.5 billion people are missing out on the opportunity to hear the Gospel. They are living in pockets of lostness, hidden behind cultural, physical, political and language barriers to a Gospel witness. God calls every church and every believer to be on mission with Him to break down the barriers. Could it be that one of the barriers to reaching these pockets is a lack of financial resources?

Our goal for 2009 is \$140,000! Please prayerfully consider how you can give to the Global Missions Offering.

The offering began December 6 and will continue through our 2010 Missions Conference which will be held March 7-14. You can give at any time during this period. You can use your standard offering envelope and mark "Global Missions" or the GMO envelope in the pews. Although not encouraged, you may designate your offering to one specific offering area, e.g. Lottie Moon or Short-Term Missions. If you do this, please write this on the memo line of your check. Remember -- this offering is above your normal tithe to CBC.

For 2009, the breakdown of the GMO is as follows:

- Lottie Moon Christmas offering for international missions (45%) \*\*
- CBC short-term missions (40%)
- Annie Armstrong Easter offering for North American missions (10%)
- SBCV state missions offering (5%)
- Vedat Fund (\$7500)

\*\* In 2008, there was a \$29 million shortfall in the Lottie Moon offering, most likely due to the tough economy. Due to this shortfall, the International Missions Board had to severely limit the number of missionaries sent to the field in 2009. CBC can help put missionaries in the field through our GMO giving! This will allow those who are "missing" to hear the good news of the Savior!



# Are You Making Plans?

Meals are provided to Vedat and the Hatcher family twice a week. Additional team members are needed to serve in this area. Many options are available, including donating

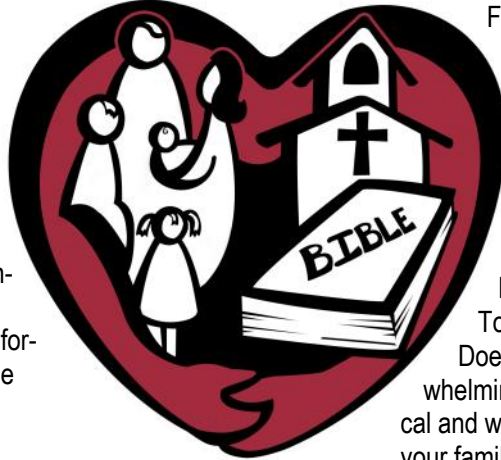
